## Notes

1. Part time study is available for these courses, please ask for details. The tuition fee is spread evenly over the years of study. The course can be studied from 1 to 5 years.
2. All students on a validated course pay this fee annually which is set to cover Open University charges. This fee applies for the first three years of study.
3. Tuition fees are spread over the period in which study is undertaken. Annual University registration fees apply.

For the bridging courses, if two or more modules are completed, you will be entitled to a credit towards the first term fees of the postgraduate course.

For two modules completed and paid in full £120 credit, three modules £240 and four modules £360. This is the maximum credit towards the postgraduate first term course fees.

The credit is purely for the continuation of the postgraduate programme. No discount or refund applies if you haven't been enrolled or accepted into the postgraduate programme.

5. Cost for 25/26 is £45 per year for campus & hybrid access learners.
6. All students accessing their studies on the College campus and not staying or living in a College property on the Easneye estate (whether in full board or self-catered accommodation) will need to pay this fee. The full time fee applies to all campus access learners except those who only come to campus up to 3 days per week. Remote access learners may pay the per day charge for occasional visits. The fee includes access to all student areas of the site and includes weekday lunches and drinks during the undergraduate 10 week terms. Outside of the undergraduate terms postgraduate students may visit up to 31st July and pay the daily amenities rate of £6.30 per visit.

7. This applies per person and runs from 24th September 2025 – 31st July 2026, excluding 10 days over Christmas and 4 days over Easter when the College is closed. It includes all meals and drinks as well as linen changes. If it is necessary to close the kitchens for additional time over Christmas, a rebate for food will be available.

8. A limited number of rental properties of varying sizes are available on site for families. These have their own monthly rental charges. Please enquire for details of available properties.

## Other charges:

**Application fees:** £52.50 for postgraduate courses. This is non-refundable.

**Course Deposit fees:** £370. This is non-refundable but will be deducted from your fees.

**Cash payment charge:** whilst the College accepts payments by cash, this is limited. Students wishing to pay their fees in cash will face a charge of £50 a time if they exceed cash payments of £500 per person per calendar month, with a monthly limit of £1,000 per person.

**Guest attendance at lectures:** this may be possible with the prior consent of the lecturer concerned. The first hour is free, subsequent hours are charged at £16 per hour.

**Continuation Fees:** if you continue beyond the normal length of your course there will be additional costs. The Postgraduate Continuation fees are £525 per annum.

**Room and House deposits on site:** A deposit of £50 per room is required for those in full board accommodation and a deposit of £600 is required for a self-catered property. These will be refunded if the accommodation is left in an acceptable condition.

They should be paid through the College website at the same time as the course deposit, on acceptance of a place.

**Keys:** Refundable room key deposits are £20. Lost key fobs are £20.
