*The Certificate and Diploma programmes are also available to take as un-validated courses in which case the Open University Registration fee will not apply and you will exit with an All Nations Certificate or Diploma.

Notes

- Part time study is available for these courses, please ask for details. All levels can now be studied via remote access (i.e. by participating via computer in live classes). Tuition fees are the same whether students are campus access learners or remote access learners.
- All students on a validated course pay this fee annually which is set to cover Open University charges. This fee applies for the first six years of study on this programme.
- Full Board accommodation per night rate is applicable when staying on to study other short courses eg Arts for a Better Future.
- Cost for 25/26 is £45 per year for campus & hybrid access learners.
- All students accessing their studies on College campus and **not** staying or living in a College property on the Easneye estate (whether in full board or self-catered accommodation) will need to pay this fee. The full time fee applies to all campus access learners except those who only come to campus up to 3 days per week. Remote access learners may pay the per day charge for occasional visits. The fee includes access to all student areas of the site and includes weekday lunches and drinks during term time.
- This is per person during term time which is 30 weeks per year plus orientation. It includes all meals and drinks as well as linen changes.

7. A limited number of rental properties of varying sizes are available on site for families. These have their own monthly rental charges. Please enquire for details of available properties.

Married couples discounts:

Discount A - where both are studying full-time for two years or more, in second/third year they receive a combined discount of £4,245.

Discount B - where both are studying, one full-time, one half-time over two years or more, in the second/third year they receive a combined discount of £3,140.

Couples may take up to 3 years out during their course of study and the relevant discount will still apply.

Student Loans: please note that the student loan company currently only grant up to £6,000 per year towards tuition

Other charges:

Application fees: £52.50 for undergraduate courses. This is non-refundable.

Course Deposit fees: £370 for all courses. This is non-refundable but will be deducted from your course fees.

Cash payment charge: whilst the College accepts payments by cash, this is limited. Students wishing to pay their fees in cash will face a charge of £50 a time if they exceed cash payments of £500 per person per calendar month, with a monthly limit of £1,000 per person.

Guest attendance at lectures: this may be possible with the prior consent of the lecturer concerned. The first hour is free, subsequent hours are charged at £16 per hour.

Continuation Fees: if you continue beyond the normal length of your course there will be additional costs. The Undergraduate Continuation fees are £525 per annum plus the Annual University Registration fee.

Room and House deposits on site: A deposit of £50 per room is required for those in full board accommodation and a deposit of £600 is required for a self-catered property. These will be refunded if the accommodation is left in an acceptable condition. They should be paid through the College website at the same time as the course deposit, on acceptance of a place.

Keys: Refundable room key deposits are £20. Lost key fobs are £20.
