All Nations to All Nations – We're on the Move!

A UK college has announced it is finalising discussions to move location ready for expansion. Their aim is to innovate the way Christians from the UK around the globe are equipped to work with their neighbours.

On 12th May, All Nations Christian College (ANCC) confirmed that they are discussing a move to Chester House, Muswell Hill in North London, and to make this their main teaching base in the UK for the academic year September 2026-2027. This represents the next stage in the exciting season of change they announced last May. The move helps them fulfil their purpose *“to cultivate biblically-rooted, hope-filled, and culturally relevant engagement with God’s mission by training and equipping disciples of Jesus Christ in partnership with the global church.”*

The UK relocation provides an opportunity to create intercultural learning communities not just in one location, but with partners around the world. Technology will play its part, but equipping people to work effectively with those of other cultures requires in-person learning that forms character and develops skills.

In the coming year, the college will continue to teach BA, MA and shorter courses whilst further developing partnerships and courses to equip people for mission around the world. They are planning new courses, new ways of studying together and new places to study.

The college’s CEO, Tim Young, said:

“As we engage more globally, we look forward to the richness of working with both faculty and students around the world and facilitating innovative ways of learning. Across the global church, biblically-rooted faith is expressed in beautiful and diverse ways, impacting how we worship, care for the world, and share the gospel. This transformational shift by All Nations will better equip Christians to work together, enriching the work of the gospel in every nation.”
