

Modular Study Options – 2026/27

This document applies to those who wish to take individual modules rather than follow a full time programme of study. Unless otherwise specified these Fees apply to both undergraduate and postgraduate modules.

Notes

1. When applying for modules, a module application fee needs to be paid. This fee is in addition to the module Tuition fee and is non refundable. No discount or refund applies if you haven't been enrolled or accepted into the module. A further application fee will apply only in the event of a gap of more than one year between studies.
2. The Module Tuition Fee is for all modules. Students studying for modules may be eligible for a scholarship. Scholarships are awarded during the application process, prior to study. 3. Full board accommodation includes breakfast, lunch, and dinner.
4. For module students not staying overnight but visiting for the day, it is possible to buy a hot or cold lunch and receive refreshments at the college. This must be organised beforehand via email ma@allnations.ac.uk.
- 5-6. If you are studying an undergraduate module and would like to have your assessment or assignment marked the fees are shown and are dependent on the number of credits for that module.

General

Modular students cannot be registered with the Open University, so marked assignments will not gain transferrable credits. The College will however provide all students with a letter of attendance or transcript stating the modules were part of The OU validated undergraduate programme.
