***Modules offered for the academic year 2026-27 can also be taken as non-accredited courses in which case the Open University Registration fee will not apply, and you will receive a transcript of marks issued from All Nations Christian College.**

Notes

1. Tuition fees are the same for campus access learners and remote access learners. All programme levels can be studied via remote access, with students participating in live classes online via computer.
2. All students enrolled on a validated course are required to pay this fee annually, which is set to cover Open University charges. This fee applies for the first six years of study on this programme.
3. Students studying for modules may be eligible for a scholarship. Scholarships are awarded during the application process, prior to study. 4. The Full Board accommodation per night rate applies when students remain on site to study additional short courses and if they are staying outside term time.
5. This is the annual student body fee for campus access and hybrid access learners.

6-7. The full-time fee applies to those attending more than three days per week. Students attending three days or fewer per week will be charged the part-time fee. Students who primarily study remotely may instead pay a per day charge for occasional visits to campus. The fee includes access to all student areas on site, as well as weekday lunches and drinks during term time.

8. Full Board accommodation is being kept the same as 2025-26 in 2026-27 for continuing students only.

Married couples discounts:

Discount A - where both are studying full-time for two years or more, in second/third year they receive a combined discount of £4,245.

Discount B - where both are studying, one full-time, one part-time over two years or more, in the second/third year they receive a combined discount of £3,140.

Couples may take up to 3 years out during their course of study and the relevant discount will still apply.

Student Loans: please note that from September 2026, the student loan company grant up to £6,165 per year towards tuition fees.

Other charges:

Application fees: £60 for undergraduate courses. This is non-refundable.

Course Deposit fees: £400 for all courses. This is non-refundable but will be deducted from your course fees.

Making payments: The College does not accept payments in cash. Payments may be made directly to the College bank account via BACS or standing order, via the College website or by card payment where available.

Guest attendance at lectures: This may be possible with the prior consent of the lecturer concerned. The first hour is free, subsequent hours are charged at £20 per hour.

Continuation Fees: if you continue beyond the normal length of your course there will be additional costs. The Undergraduate Continuation fees are £545 per annum plus the Annual University Registration fee.

Room deposits (on site): A room deposit of £250, will be required for students in full board accommodation. This deposit will be refunded, subject to the accommodation being left in an acceptable condition. Deposits must be paid via the College website at the same time as the course deposit, upon acceptance of a place.
