This summer, we're leaving Easneye as God leads All Nations into a new season. We're deeply grateful for your prayers and support as we seek new ways to see the name of the Lord glorified.

Our mission remains the same: to provide biblically rooted, cross-cultural mission training. However, God is leading us to deliver that training in ways that are more flexible, accessible, affordable and better suited to the needs of today's global church. You can read more about this here.

Two weeks ago, we launched an urgent appeal to help fund this transition. Our goal is to raise £250,000 by the end of December. So far, £23,500 has been given. Please pray for God's continued provision as we step forward in faith.

Out and About



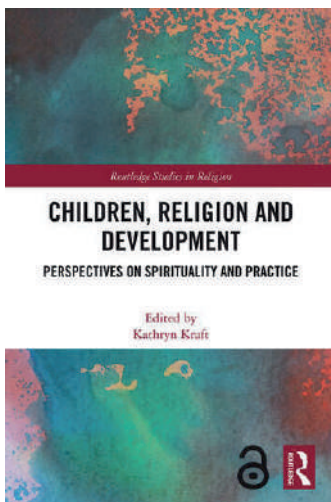
All Nations was well represented at EMDC where more than 700 missionaries, media distributors, content designers, trainers, and tech developers from over 200 different organisations gathered in Chiang Mai, Thailand, in May. All Nations offered a 4-day training track on course design during pre-EMDC, a 4-day training track on ethical storytelling during post-EMDC, and three seminars during the main EMDC conference with a particular focus on AI, ethics, and photography.

Over the course of the year staff and students have been promoting the College through the Christian Unions Global Connections Eastern Partnerships forum. It has been a joy to connect with college and university students.

We have also attended a number of Intercultural forums and conferences around the UK and been part of important and developing conversations and networks.

The College's Hearts for Mission Team have visited a number of local churches over the past year delivering bespoke services for different churches and encouraging them in mission.

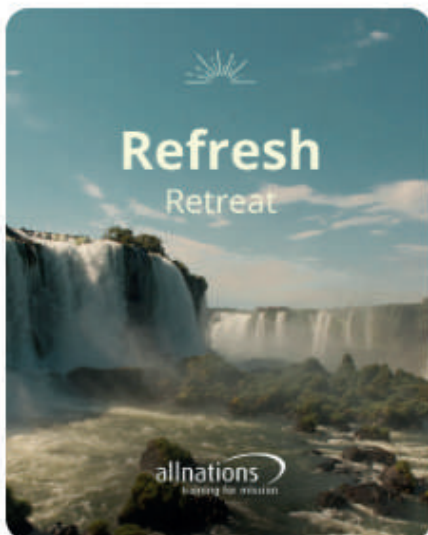


Express 13-17 July
