Notes

1. This course is now available on campus or by zoom
2. Spot-*lites* are additional 1-week specialist topics that can be taken at the end of the *explore* course. These can be taken for £49 per topic, with a 10% reduction if participants sign up during the application stage.
3. Price includes full board accommodation for 5 nights. Reduced rates may apply: Group rate of 2 or more £350, full time student rate £300.
4. Price and details to be confirmed. Current cost in 21/22 is £18 per year for campus access learners.
5. All students accessing the College campus and **not** staying or living in a College property on the Easneye estate (whether in full board or self-catered accommodation) will need to pay this fee. The fee includes access to all student areas of the site and includes weekday lunches and drinks in term time.
6. This is per person during term time for 10 weeks (termly) or 30 weeks (annual). It includes all meals and drinks as well as linen changes.
7. A limited number of rental properties of varying sizes are available on site for families. These have their own monthly rental charges. Please enquire for details of available properties.

Married Couples discount C - Explore Online course only - where both are studying they receive a discount of 20% on the second student's fees.

Other charges:

Application fees: £25 for En Route, £15 for Explore. This is non-refundable.

Course Deposit fees: a £350 deposit applies for En Route. This is non-refundable but will be deducted from your course fees.

Cash payment charge: whilst the College accepts payments by cash, this is limited. Students wishing to pay their fees in cash will face a charge of £50 a time if they exceed cash payments of £500 per person per calendar month, with a monthly limit of £1,000 per person.

Guest attendance at lectures: this may be possible with the prior consent of the lecturer concerned. The first hour is free, subsequent hours are charged at £15 per hour.

Room and House deposits on site: A deposit of £50 per room is required for those in full board accommodation and a deposit of £600 is required for a self-catered property. These will be refunded if the accommodation is left in an acceptable condition. They should be paid through the College website at the same time as the course deposit, on acceptance of a place.

Keys: Refundable room key deposits are £20. Lost key fobs are £15.
