Maple Hall was built in 1986 to make space for the expanding library in our main building, Easneye House. The internal fittings of Maple Hall are much the same as in 1986, but showing signs of age and wear. Careful stewardship of resources and repairs have kept furniture going despite heavy use for more than 30 years. However, many tables and chairs are coming to the end of their usefulness, and the carpet is worn through in places, with some trip hazards.

Maple Hall is the heart of All Nations – the place where people meet for nourishment for the body, mind and soul. It's also used extensively by guests attending day and residential conferences. It's a place where the All Nations community comes together, friendships are formed, and students, staff and guests engage in conversation with people from around the world as part of their preparation for mission in all nations.

We're planning a refurbishment of Maple Hall which will better reflect the spirit of a vibrant multicultural Christian community and college at the forefront of cross-cultural mission training. Funds permitting, the refurbishment will involve:



**a suspended ceiling** – improving insulation, keeping the hall warmer, reducing heating costs and improving sound quality



**LED lighting** – improving light quality and energy efficiency, possibly including portable stage lights for arts and drama projects and college events



**tables and chairs** – replacing outdated furniture with smart practical tables and chairs for college and conference use, possibly with a seating area with a TV for international news and college news feeds



**kitchen equipment** – a blast chiller to improve chilling of cooked food, a chiller for our salad bar, and possibly a fire suppression system for the main cooking area



**decorating** – a smart new appearance to create a more welcoming environment and reflect the ethos of All Nations
