

What do I do next?

So... you've seen the promo video, or read something about EnVision in a leaflet or online, and you would like to get a group together to work through the course. What do you do next?

1. Discuss

Please discuss the possibility of taking EnVision with your church or organisation. The person who is appointed to take this forward will need to do the following:

2. Get in touch!

Write to us at envision@allnations.ac.uk to let us know that your church or organisation would like to **register** with us. We will send more detailed information about what's involved (meals, videos, discussion, online material).

3. Form a group

- a. **Gather together a group of people** who are willing to commit to the 4 sessions. In order to make the most of the course, the participants will be Christians who have an **interest in mission** and reaching out to those of other cultures (whether at home or abroad). Or, they may know someone who is working cross-culturally and would like to be able to support them better.
- b. **Once registered, share** with the group the key objectives of the course material and discuss the specific context of the group so that you can be more targeted in what you hope to get from the resource. You will be in a better position to advise the group, and recruit others, if you are familiar with the course content. We can give you access to the videos and online resources to help you with this.
- c. **Fix a start date** and put it in your diaries! Inform us of this date.
- d. **At least 2 weeks** before your start date, send us the names and email addresses of the participants so that we can give them access to the resources on the EnVision website. This will also give us plenty of time to send relevant information and ensure everyone is ready.
- e. If there are people in your group who are not IT savvy, please be prepared to help them with this.
