## Why Choose En Route?

If you are interested or involved in cross-cultural ministry and service, whether at home or abroad, and have 10 weeks available for training, then En Route is for you.

## What Is En Route?

En Route is a ten week programme of essential training that covers the basics of cross-cultural mission. There are now over 400 graduates from at least 30 countries who have completed this course. It is aimed at those who are considering cross-cultural work but have little or no previous training, as well as those with some experience who are looking to reflect and build on their understanding. It is suitable for those who desire to be engaged in cross-cultural mission through their local church and/or a Christian mission agency, both locally and globally.

Course topics are built around 5 modules:

<b>Who am I?</b>	Understanding our identity and personality in relation to God and others. Living in a learning community, working in teams and handling transition.
<b>The Bible and Mission</b>	Exploring the Bible’s missional narrative and examining mission in the early church, across the centuries and in our world today.
<b>Culture and Religion</b>	Developing an understanding of culture, worldview and religious traditions, and their implications for our life and work.
<b>Relating and Integrating Across Cultures</b>	Dealing with the practical issues of cross-cultural work and equipping students with the tools for cross-cultural living.
<b>Integral Mission: Building God’s Kingdom</b>	Exploring evangelism, discipleship, church-planting, creation care, poverty and development, and arts in mission.

## Explore

### Why Choose Explore?

If you are considering cross-cultural mission service and need some flexibility in your studies, then our 13 week online mission training course is for you. Explore has been taken in 31 locations around the world.

### What Is Explore?

Explore is our thirteen week online course providing a foundation for cross-cultural mission service and an opportunity for you to Explore God’s purposes for your life. It is intended to form part of an on-going journey in training and service. As part of an online community, you will participate in an interactive course written and facilitated by a training team who have current mission experience. Course topics are built around 4 modules:

- Who am I?
- What is mission?
- Culture and living in community
- Integral mission

The course will provide you with a Biblical foundation for your life and ministry. Examining the issues of effective teamwork and how to develop and maintain healthy relationships will also be studied.

You will gain a deeper understanding of culture, current trends in mission and the effects of transition, enabling you to relate and integrate more easily across cultures. A variety of tools will be provided throughout the course including programme planning and management.
