

What do I do next?

So... you've seen the promo video, or read something about EnVision in a leaflet or online, and you would like to get a group together to work through the course. What do you do next?

1. Discuss

Please discuss the possibility of taking EnVision with your church or organisation. The person who is appointed to take this forward will need to do the following:

2. Get in touch!

Write to us at envision@allnations.ac.uk to let us know that your church or organisation would like to **register** with us. We will send more detailed information about what's involved.

3. Form a group

- a. **Once registered, gather together a group of people** who are willing to commit to the 4 sessions. In order to make the most of the course, the participants will be Christians who have an **interest in mission** and reaching out to those of other cultures (whether at home or abroad). Or, they may know someone who is working cross-culturally and would like to be able to support them better.
- b. **Share** with the group the key objectives of the course and discuss the specific context of the group so that you can maximise the effectiveness of the material. You will be in a better position to advise the group, and recruit others, if you are familiar with the course content. We can give you access to the videos and online resources to help you with this.
- c. **Fix a start date** and put it in your diaries! Inform us of this date.
- d. **At least 1 week** before your start date, send us a **spreadsheet or table** with the headings: First name, Surname, Email address for each participant so that we can give them access to the EnVision website. They will need to take a few minutes to do that preparatory activities before each session.
- e. If there are people in your group who are not IT savvy, please help them with this.
