After completing our En Route short course, a married couple moved to Liberia where they are now directing the national branch of Serving in Mission (SIM).



A young female graduate moved to Uganda with Africa Inland Mission International (AIM). She is a University Chaplain and has set up a popular Physiotherapy Degree Training Programme. She says she is living out her calling in student discipleship, workplace mission and mobilisation.





A graduate is serving with Overseas Missionary Fellowship International (OMF), focusing on outreach to the 'lu-Mien' communities alongside the Mekong River in Thailand.



Another graduate is serving in a church in Devon. She also works in a drop-in centre for people who are homeless, unemployed or lonely.
