Other Costs

MA online food & accommodation costs for intensive courses: £22.50 per night, full board.

Application Fees: £45 for undergraduate & postgraduate courses and £25 for En Route. This is non refundable.

MA Bridging Course Fee: £50

Student Body Fees: They are set at £6 per term for the year.

Course Deposit Fees: £350 for all courses except individual modules and explore. This is non refundable but will be deducted from your course fees.

Room Deposits: a room deposit of £50 is required for standard rooms. Rented family accommodation requires a deposit of £600. This will be refunded if the accommodation is left in an acceptable condition. It should be paid at the same time as the course deposit, on acceptance of a place.

Continuation Fees: if you continue beyond the normal length of your course there will be additional costs. The MA and Undergraduate Continuation fees are £500 per annum plus the £475 Open University Registration fee.

Keys: Refundable room key deposits are £20, lost key fobs are £20.

Details of other incidental costs can be found on our website.

Guest attendance at lectures: this may be possible with the prior consent of the lecturer concerned. The first hour is free, subsequent hours are charged at £15 per hour.

* Part time study is available for these courses, please ask for details.

** Food and accommodation charges will apply for attendance of the MA residential intensive course. These will depend on the length of your stay.

**** **For Undergraduate study, please note that the student loan company currently only grant up to £6,000 per year towards tuition fees. For Postgraduate study, the maximum claim for tuition fees is £6,165. Students must therefore fund the surplus.**

Married couples discounts

Discount A - where both are studying full-time for two years or more, in second/third year they receive a combined discount of £3,400.

Discount B - where both are studying, one full-time, one half-time over two years or more, in the second/third year they receive a combined discount of £2,518.

Discount C - explore online course only - where both are studying they receive a discount of 20% on the second student's fees.

Discounts do not apply to basic module study, GPS, En Route or short courses.

Couples may take up to 3 years out during their course of study and the relevant discount will still apply.
