#### Notes

1. Part time study is available for these courses, please ask for details. Level 6 can be studied online through Flexible Distributed Learning (i.e. by participating in live classes). Tuition fees for Level 6 of the undergraduate programme are the same whether students are on or off campus.

**These courses are also available to take as un-validated courses in which case The Open University Registration fee will not apply and you will exit with an All Nations Certificate or Diploma.**

2. All students on a validated course must pay this fee annually.

3. This is for students who will attend their lectures on site and goes to the student body.

4. All students who are coming on site for their studies will need to pay this fee if they are not paying full board accommodation. The fee includes access to all student areas of the site including the library, and includes weekday lunches and drinks during term time.

5. This is per person during term time so 30.5 weeks per year. It includes all meals and drinks as well as linen changes.

6. A limited number of rental properties of varying sizes are available on site for families. These have their own monthly rental charges. Students renting one of these properties will be required to pay the amenities fee. Please enquire for details of available properties.

THE MAXIMUM INCREASE IN EACH YEAR FOR TUITION FEES FOR RETURNING STUDENTS WILL NOT EXCEED THE RATE OF INFLATION, AS MEASURED BY THE UK CONSUMER PRICES INDEX (CPI).

### **Married couples discounts:**

**Discount A** - where both are studying full-time for two years or more, in second/third year they receive a combined discount of £3,561.

**Discount B** - where both are studying, one full-time, one half-time over two years or more, in the second/third year they receive a combined discount of £2,636.

Couples may take up to 3 years out during their course of study and the relevant discount will still apply.

**Student Loans:** please note that the student loan company currently only grant up to £6,000 per year towards tuition fees.

### **Other charges:**

**Application fees:** £45 for undergraduate courses. This is non-refundable.

**Course Deposit fees:** £350 for all courses. This is non-refundable but will be deducted from your course fees.

**DBS Checks:** all students will need at least a basic DBS check before they come on site. Some students may need an enhanced check depending on their placement. More details to follow.

**Guest attendance at lectures:** this may be possible with the prior consent of the lecturer concerned. The first hour is free, subsequent hours are charged at £15 per hour.

**Continuation Fees:** if you continue beyond the normal length of your course there will be additional costs. The Undergraduate Continuation fees are £500 per annum plus the Annual University Registration fee.

**Room and House deposits on site:** A deposit of £50 per room is required for singles and married couples. Family accommodation requires a deposit of £600 per family. These will be refunded if the accommodation is left in an acceptable condition. They should be paid through the College website at the same time as the course deposit, on acceptance of a place.

**Keys:** Refundable room key deposits are £20. Lost key fobs are £15.
